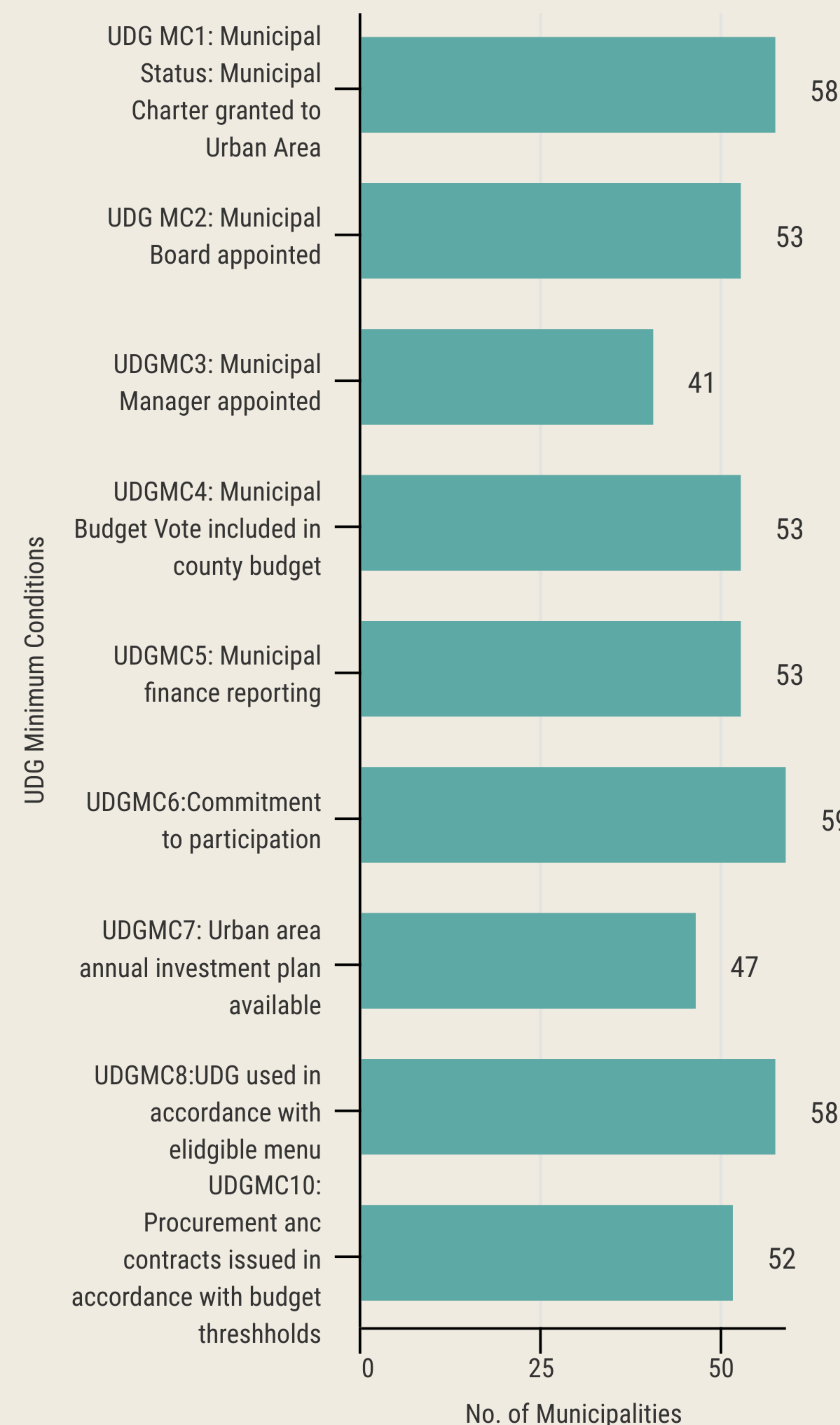

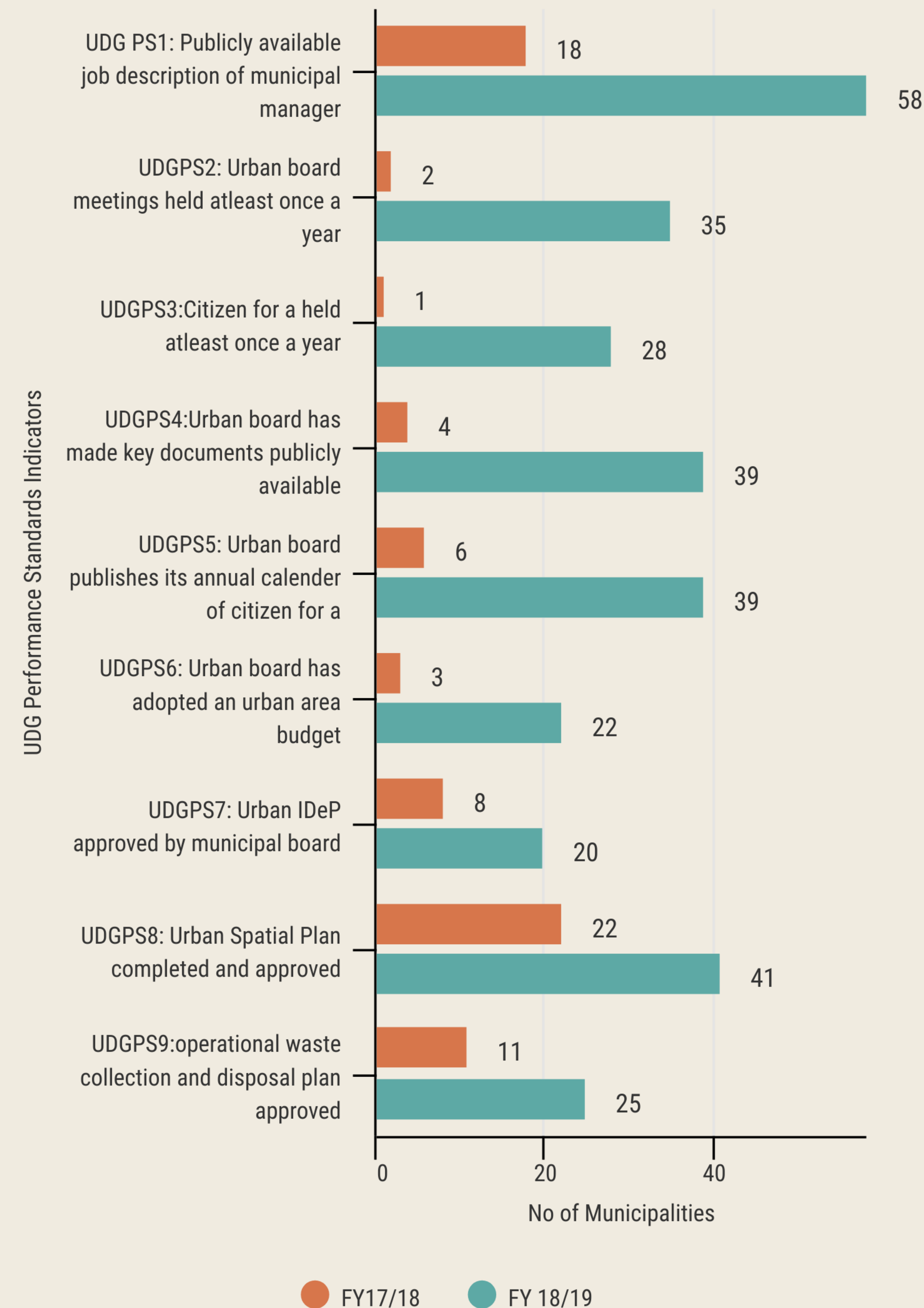

Urban Institutional Performance: Status of Minimum Conditions (FY18/19)

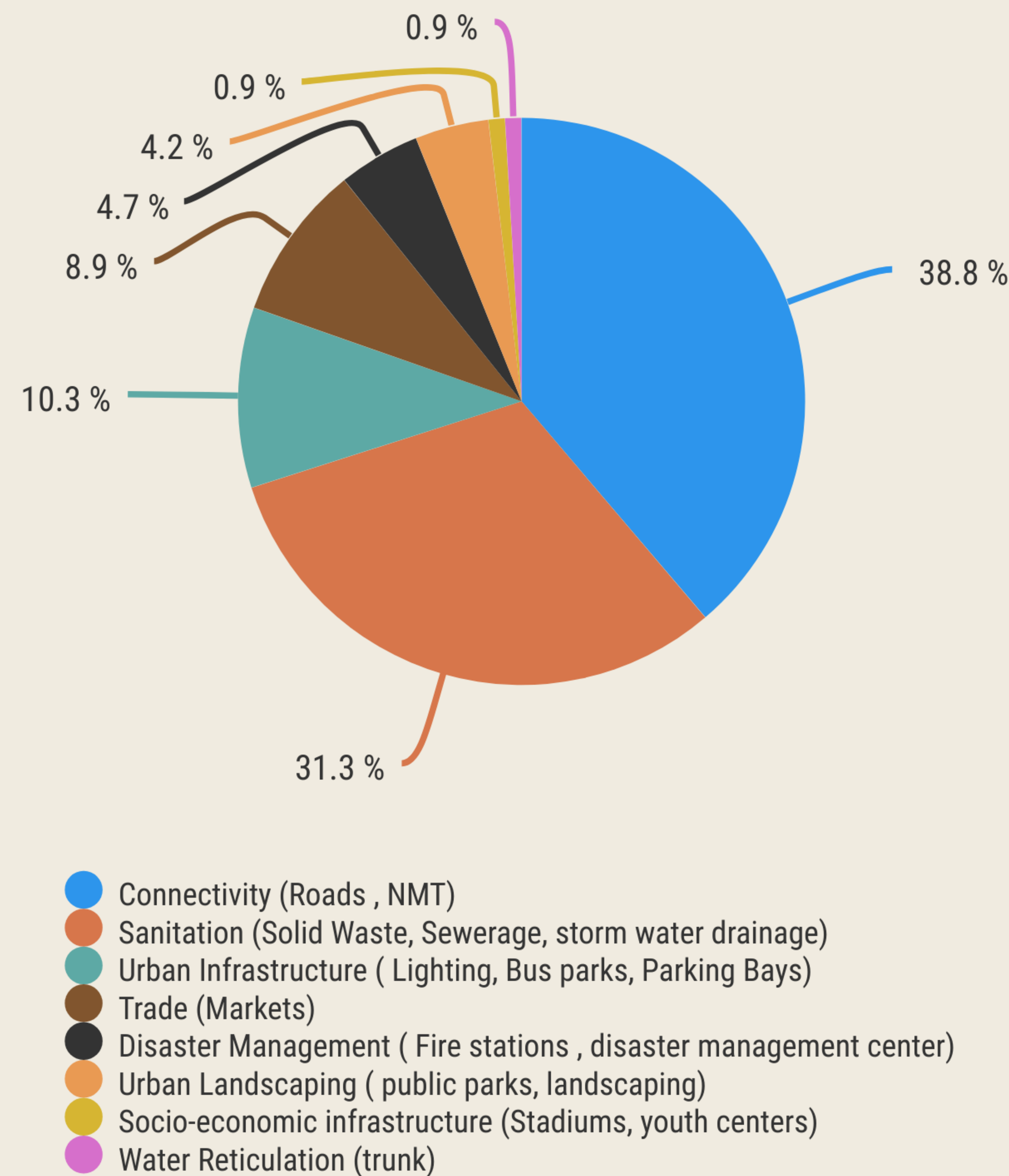

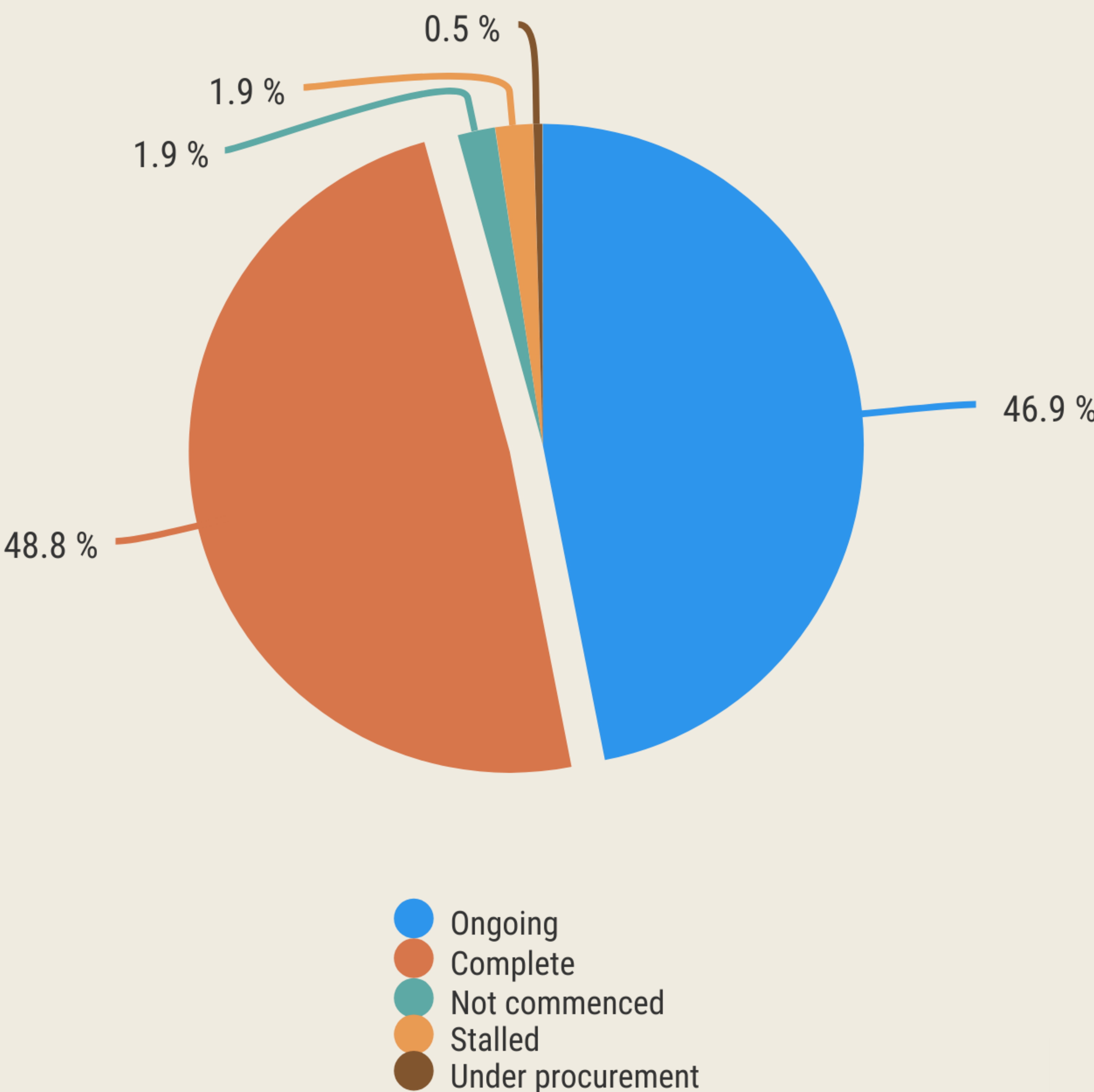

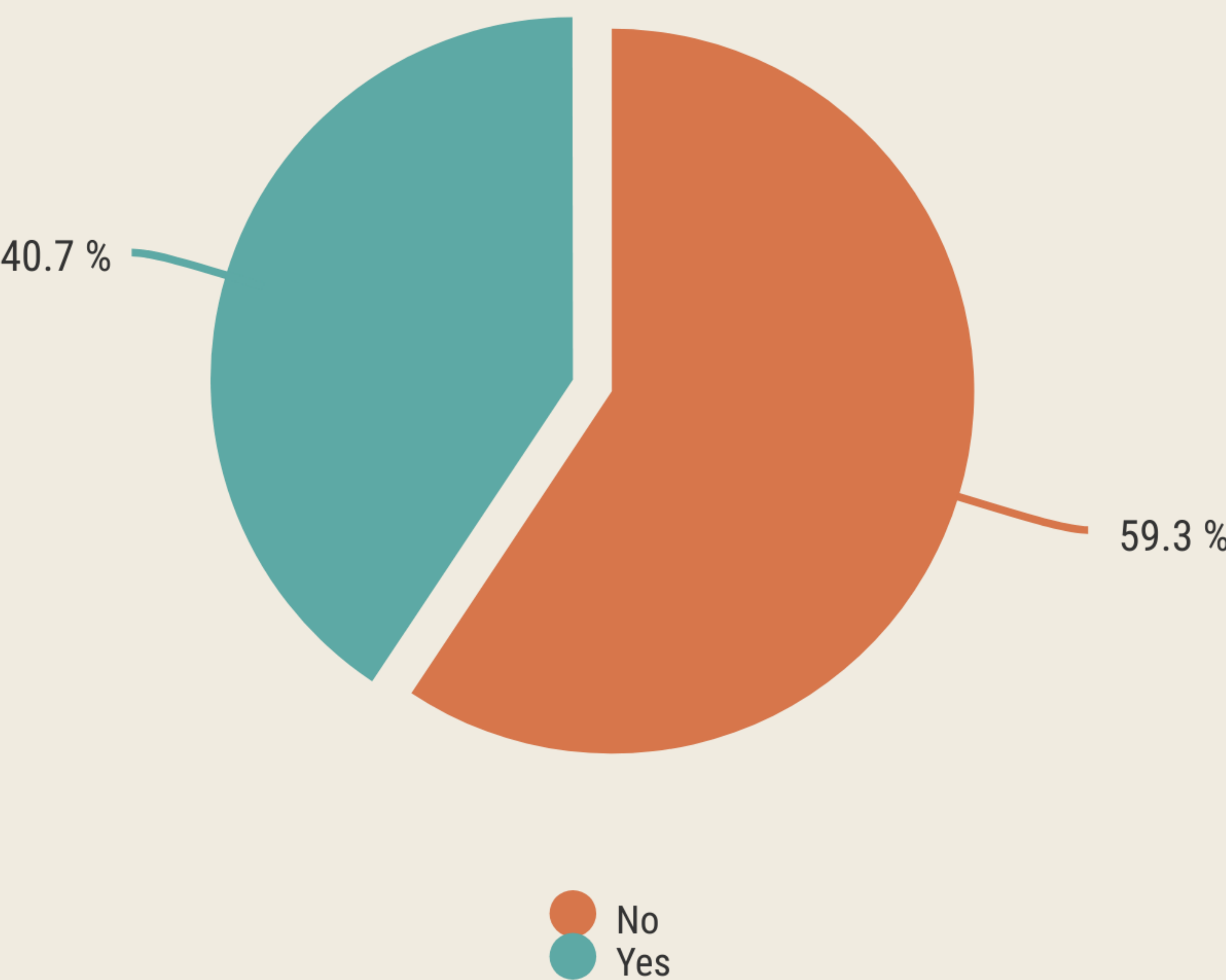
Distribution of KUSP Investments by Sector

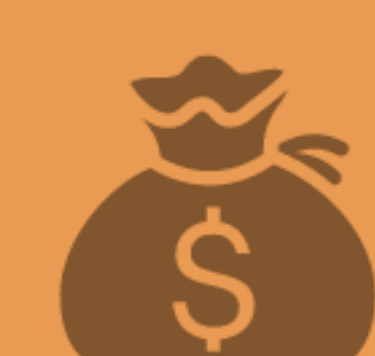

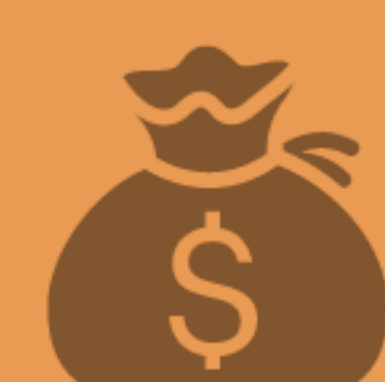

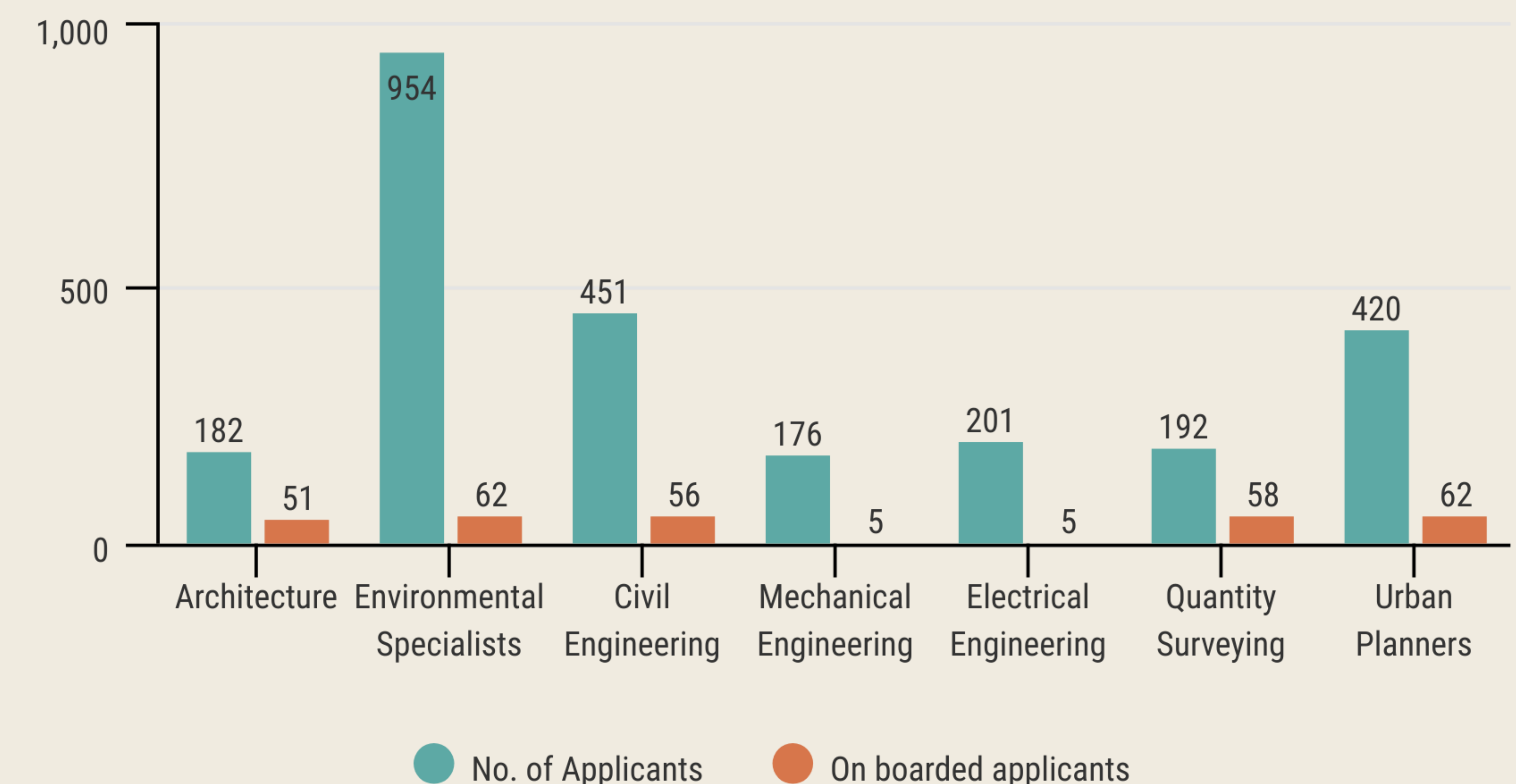

The emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic has greatly affected access to opportunities for young graduates .

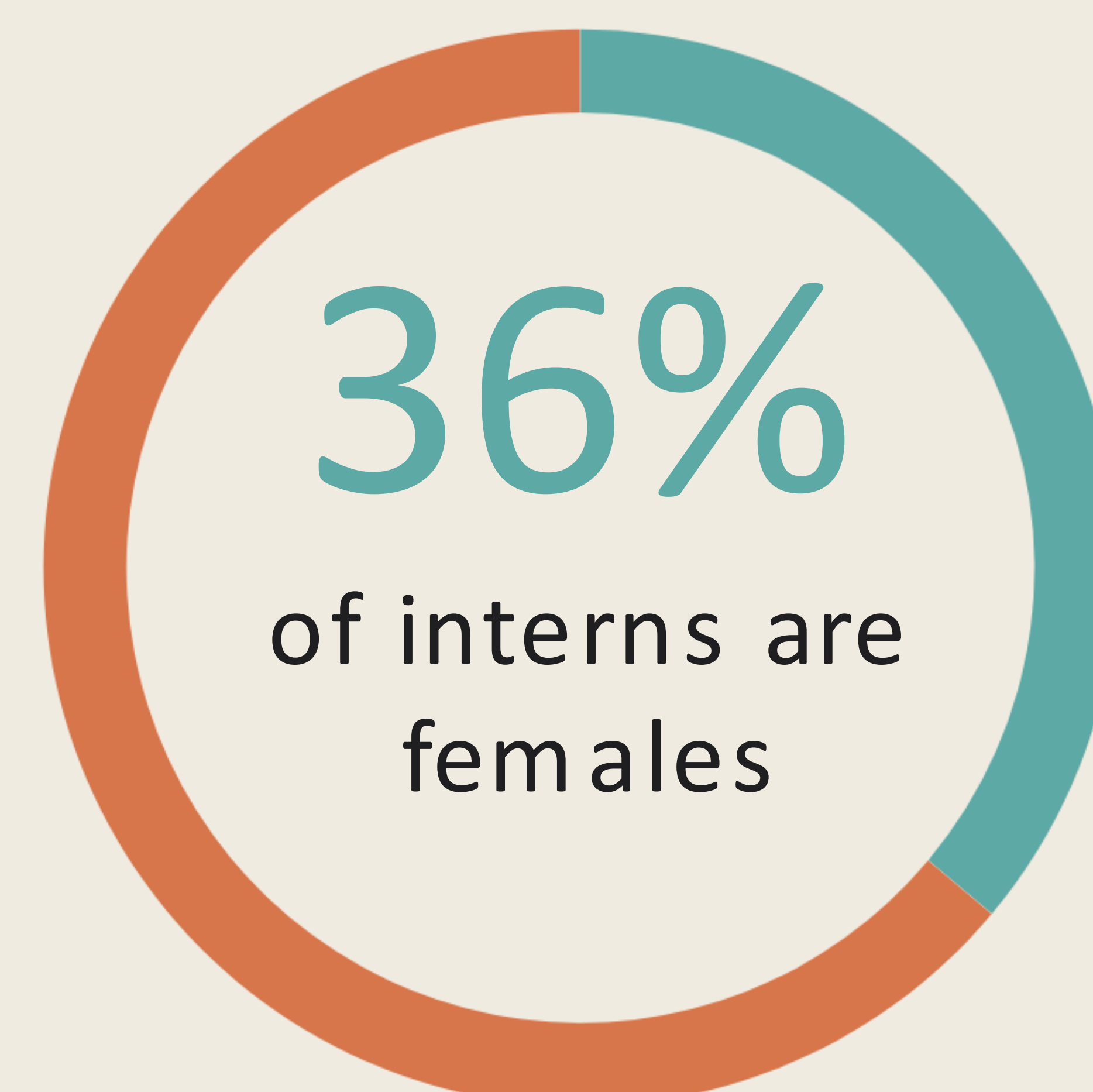
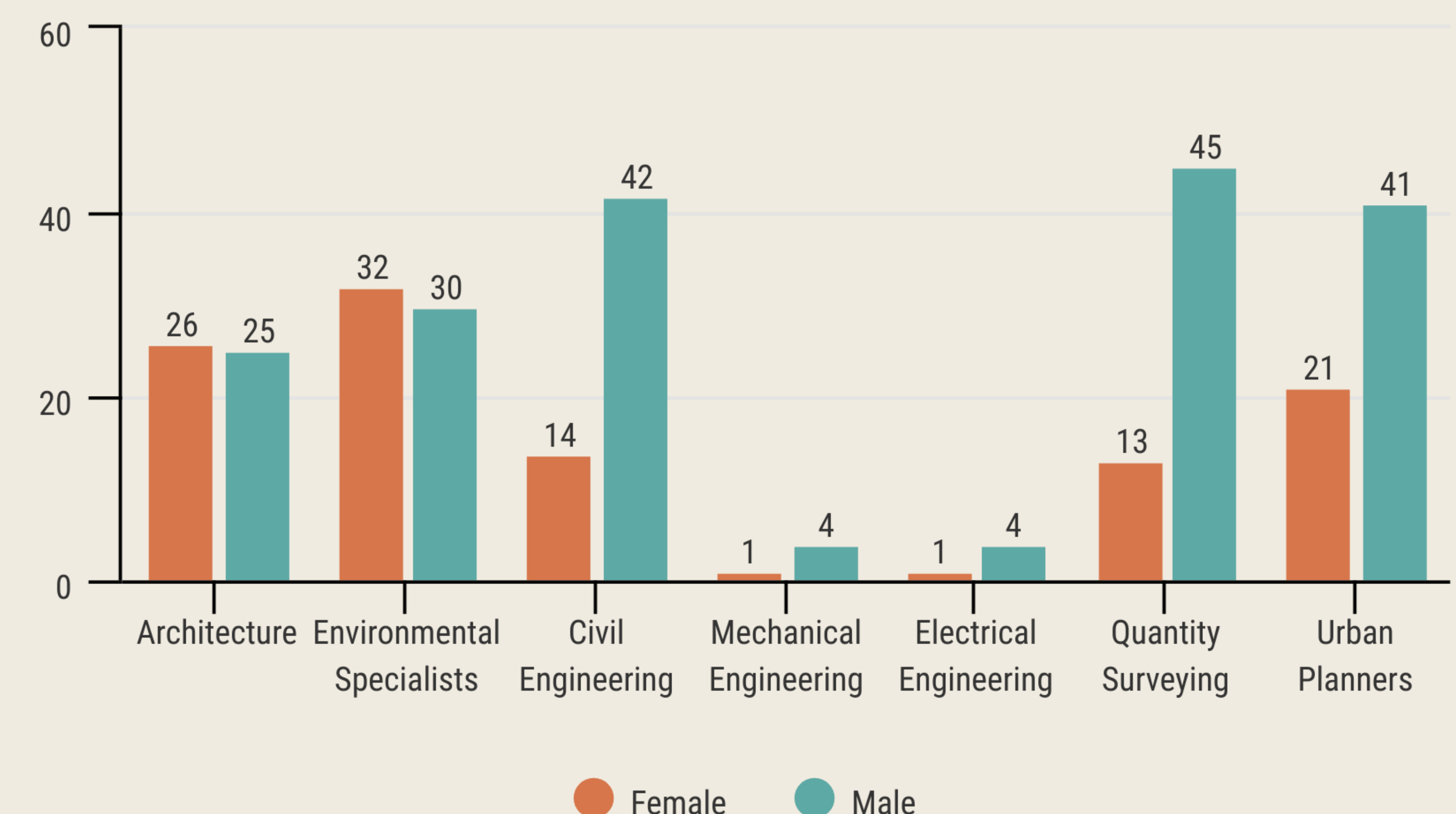
