The International Growth Centre (IGC) aims to promote sustainable growth in developing countries by providing demand-led policy advice based on frontier research. The IGC directs a global network of world-class researchers in economics, political economy and related disciplines, and a set of 15 country teams across Africa and Asia. Based at LSE and in partnership with the University of Oxford, the IGC is initiated and funded by the UK Department for International Development (DFID).

The IGC's partner countries currently include Bangladesh, Ethiopia, Ghana, India, Liberia, Mozambique, Myanmar, Pakistan, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda and Zambia. We have immediate vacancies in Zambia and Myanmar, and upcoming vacancies in Liberia and Tanzania, though candidates will also be considered for a reserve pool for all countries.

Country Directors lead IGC's impact on policy in each partner country. They provide strategic leadership for the IGC's in-country engagement, and are responsible for drawing up and implementing the Country Strategy for the timely delivery of projects and for maximising the impact of the country programme.

Successful candidates are likely to have a background in academic, civil service or international organisations, with substantial policy experience, considerable background in economics, and contacts in the given country.

These roles are part-time contractual posts, and typically based in the relevant partner country, though applications from candidates based abroad will be considered. Regular international travel will be required.
